**SHORT NOTICE INVITING QUOTATION FOR SUPPLY DRUGS AND MEDICINES**

Sealed quotations are invited from reputed manufacturers having valid rate contract with any Govt owned Medical Procurement Corporation; ESIC; CGHS or any State Government Health Department for supply of drugs to Government Health Institutions located in different districts of Jharkhand with following terms and conditions and as per format at Annexure I, II, III & IV. The quotations should reach the office of The Managing Director, Jharkhand Medical & Health Infrastructure Development & Procurement Corporation Ltd. (JMHDPC), MCH Building, RCH Campus, Namkum, Ranchi – 834010 by 12.00 P.M. on 05.11.2015. The sealed quotations shall be opened on the same day at 2.00 P. M. in the office of The Managing Director, JMHDPC, Jharkhand.

• **Terms & Conditions:-**

1. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs 50,000/- only in the form of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque with validity of at least 3 months favoring "Jharkhand Medical & Health Infrastructure Development & Procurement Corporation Ltd" payable at Ranchi. Earnest Money Deposit in any other form will not be accepted. Earnest Money Deposit will also not earn any interest.
2. The specification and quantity of the required items is given at **Annexure I**. The quantity indicated in the bid document is tentative and subject to change depending on actual requirement.
3. The drugs offered for supply shall be in **GENERIC NAME** only. The composition and strength of each product should be as per details given in **Annexure-I**. Any variation found will result in the rejection of the bid
4. Delivery of the ordered items shall be affected at State Warehouse, GVI, Campus, Ranchi, Jharkhand or as specified in the Purchase Order.
5. Arrangement of Road Permits for despatch of consignments shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder (s).
6. **The Bidder shall have to submit self attested copy of valid Rate Contract with any Govt owned Medical Procurement Corporation; ESIC; CGHS or any State Government Health Department (State Level) for all or any of the drugs listed at Annexure I and the same should clearly be highlighted along**

**with copy of valid Manufacturing License (of the product offered) and Drug License.**

7. The rate quoted per unit in **Annexure-II** shall be on door delivery basis inclusive of excise duty, sales tax, packaging charge, freight charge, transit Insurance and any other incidental charge. The component of tax should also be shown separately. The price quoted by the bidders shall not, in any case, exceed the controlled price, if any, fixed by the Government and the Maximum Retail Price (MRP). The soft copy of the price bid should also be submitted.
8. Bids will be evaluated with reference to landed price to determine the lowest price.
9. The supply should be started within 45 days and should be completed within 60 days from the date of purchase order or as specified in the Purchase Order. In case there is delay in delivery beyond the stipulated period there shall be reduction in price @ 1.0 % of the value of delayed goods per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total delayed goods.
10. All supplies will be scheduled for the period from the date of purchase order till the date of completion stipulated in the purchase order. The supplied medicines and drugs (covered in SCHEDULE P of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940) should have a maximum potency throughout the shelf life period as prescribed in the Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940 and rules there under. All other items of drugs and medicines should have shelf-life of minimum 5/6<sup>th</sup> of Self Life.
11. The selected bidder has to supply all ordered items with inscription "Govt. of Jharkhand, NOT FOR SALE". No MRP should be written on any ordered items.
12. 100 % payments towards the supply of items will be made on submission of invoices along with receipted delivery challans and batch wise test analysis report from an NABL accredited laboratory.
13. The supplier shall execute an agreement on non-judicial stamp paper of value of Rs.100/- (stamp duty to be paid by the supplier) as per the specified format within 5 days from the date of issue of the Letter of Acceptance and shall also submit performance security of 5 % of the total order value in the form of a Bank Guarantee from a nationalized Bank valid for a period of 12 months from the date of order. . However, if the supplier fails to execute the order or fails to perform the services as per agreement, in addition to other penal actions, the bank guarantee shall be encashed and the amount will be forfeited by Tender Inviting Authority
14. Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to inspect or get it inspected by an authorized third party or an accredited lab whatsoever from one or all lots of supplies in one or all the district as may be deemed fit.
15. Manufacturers which have been blacklisted either by the Tender Inviting Authority or by any State Government or Central Government Organization shall not be allowed to participate in the tender during the period of blacklisting.
16. The L1 bidder shall make its own arrangements to see that the Sales Tax, VAT for the supplied items is deposited in the Account of Government of Jharkhand.

17. Tender Inviting Authority reserves the right to accept or reject the quotations wholly or partially at any time of bid without assigning any reason whatsoever to anyone.
18. The contract shall be governed by the laws in force in India. In the event of any dispute arising out of the bid such dispute would be subject to the jurisdiction of the Court within the Jurisdiction of Ranchi.
